

Things to Know When Visiting

HAYFIELDS STATE PARK

PARK BASICS

- The park is open dawn to dusk.
- Guests have access to port-a-johns. ADA facilities are available.
- No overnight accommodations are available in the park.
- Guests must pack in/pack out food & drink. There are no concessions sales in the park.

AMENITIES

- Picnic tables are available at each parking lot.
- Fishing allowed (license required).

TRAILS

- Trails are easy to moderate.
- Guests have access to multiple trails including loop and scenic overlook trails.
- Bicycles are allowed on the trails.
- Pets are welcome, but they must be leashed.

VISITOR TIP

Bring water, snacks and gear to make the most of your visit.

- ATVs or dirt bikes
- Horses
- Trailers/RVs
